Reading "12 Step program for an Ecologic Civilization" Church For Our Common Home is God centered and guided and dedicated to Mother Earth. The Secret Prayer Garden invites interfaith prayers and a new dream for the Earth at the John Cobb Eco Farm with twelve prayer stations, on trees over five acres. We work for an Ecologic Civilization with our 12 step program and we;



- 1. Share the truth that the current 6th extinction of life on Earth, the only one created by humans, is an invitation for transformation as a human species.
- 2. Share the history and human habits of dominant over relationships and commit to relationships of collaboration, partnership and co-creativity.
- 3. Make amends for our alienation and abuse of the natural world and our idolatry of scientism and rationalism using transdisciplinary reconnections of religion, art, psychology, ecology, etc.
- 4. Explore eco-feminist and process theology, celebrating God and Goddess language, symbols and relationships.
- 5. Study the teachings of Jesus and Mary Magdalene and their Church of Love highlighting the radical teachings and the way of doing unto the least of these, love of enemies and service to God not money, with newly found gnostic scriptures and the world's ancient wisdom traditions.
- 6. Offer diverse spiritual practices to develop loving relationships with the natural world, Mother Earth and all creation.
- 7. Honor the invisible realms of dreams, prayer, intuition, parapsychology and imagination.
- 8. Celebrate the visual and performing arts, ritual making, beauty and creativity as divine spiritual practice.
- 9. Celebrate intergenerational community by intentionally including and honoring the very young and old.
- 10. Encourage consciousness raising with integration of body, sexuality, mind, spirit, feelings, intuition and imagination.



11. Work for social justice locally and globally in partnership with other organizations 12. Experiment with nontraditional church in order to create relevant, spirit filled and loving community.

Ambassador of Algeria to the United Nations RE: Hold Israel Responsible by Invoking the Genocide Convention

Dear Mr. Ambassador,

My name is [_ _ _] and I live in the United States of America. I am a concerned citizen who is trying to hold Israel responsible for its war-crimes.

I am writing today to implore you to help stop the slaughter of innocent lives in Palestine by invoking the Genocide Convention. Your nation has been rightly critical of Israel in the past, and I have hope that you will rise to the occasion to invoke the Genocide Convention at the International Court of Justice (ICJ).

Many people have called what is happening in Palestine, and in Gaza in particular, a genocide, including human rights organizations around the world. Already, more than 17,000 civilians have been killed (70% of them women and children), 46,000 have been wounded and dozens of hospitals, schools, mosques, churches, sewage systems and power stations, have been completely leveled. Craig Mokhiber and Craig Murray, both leading international lawyers at the UN, have also described this as a textbook case of genocide.

To make it clear, I am not asking you to determine that a genocide is occurring. I am simply asking that you *invoke* the Genocide Convention at the ICJ, so that the court itself can make a determination. A single country is all that is required to make the request. I believe that previous comments that your leaders and ambassadors have made will allow you to be an excellent messenger for this action. Please help to stop the genocide before more innocent civilians are massacred.

I thank you for your time and for your past admirable record of calling out Israel for its crimes against humanity. I look forward to hearing your response to my letter and I will continue to study the issue in the coming weeks and months.
