Meditation: "In God's eyes, the killers were part of His family, deserving of love and forgiveness. I knew that I couldn't ask God to love me if I were unwilling to love His Children. At that moment, I prayed for the killers, for their sins to be forgiven. I prayed that God would lead them to recognize the horrific error of their ways before their life on Earth ended—before they were called to account for their mortal sins. I help on to my father's rosary and asked God to help me, and again I heard his voice: Forgive them; they know not what they do. I took a crucial step toward forgiving the killers that day. My anger was drained was drained from me—I'd opened my heart to God, and He's touched it with His infinite love. For the first time, I pitied the killers. I asked God to forgive their sins and turn their souls toward His beautiful light. That night I prayed with a clear conscience and a clean heart. Reading "12 Step program for an Ecologic Civilization" Church For Our Common Home is God centered and guided and dedicated to Mother Earth. The Secret Prayer Garden invites interfaith prayers and a new dream for



the Earth at the John Cobb Eco Farm with twelve prayer stations, on trees over five acres. We work for an Ecologic Civilization with our 12 step program and we;

1. Share the truth that the current 6th extinction of life on Earth, the only one created by humans, is an invitation for transformation as a human species.

2. Share the history and human habits of dominant over relationships and commit to relationships of collaboration, partnership and co-creativity.

3. Make amends for our alienation and abuse of the natural world and our idolatry of scientism and rationalism using transdisciplinary reconnections of religion, art, psychology, ecology, etc.

4. Explore eco-feminist and process theology, celebrating God and Goddess language, symbols and relationships.

5. Study the teachings of Jesus and Mary Magdalene and their Church of Love highlighting the radical teachings and the way of doing unto the least of these, love of enemies and service to God not money, with newly found gnostic scriptures and the world's ancient wisdom traditions.

6. Offer diverse spiritual practices to develop loving relationships with the natural world, Mother Earth and all creation.

7. Honor the invisible realms of dreams, prayer, intuition, parapsychology and imagination.

8. Celebrate the visual and performing arts, ritual making, beauty and creativity as divine spiritual practice.

9. Celebrate intergenerational community by intentionally including and honoring the very young and old. 10. Encourage consciousness <u>raising</u> with integration of body, sexuality, mind, spirit, feelings, intuition and imagination.



11. Work for social justice locally and globally in partnership with other organizations 12. Experiment with nontraditional church in order to create relevant, spirit filled and loving community.

Reading "I found a place in the bathroom to call my own: a small corner of my heart. I retreated there as soon as I awoke, and stayed there until I slept. It was my sacred garden, where I spoke to God, mediated on His words, and nurtured my spiritual self. When I mediated, I touched the source of my faith and strengthened the core of my soul. While horror swirled around me, I found refuge in a world that became more welcoming and wonderful with each visit. Even as my body shriveled, my soul was nourished through my deepening relationship with God. I entered my special space through prayer; once inside, I prayed nonstop, using my rosary as an anchor to force my thoughts and energies on God. The rosary beads helped me concentrate on the gospels and keep the word of God alive in my mind. I prayed in silence, but always mouthed the word to convince myself that I was really saying them...otherwise, doubt would creep in and the negative energy would
